Our team of trained support staff will be working as part of our inclusion team with all of our children who have an IDP for additional learning needs, or require additional specific support to meet their educational or emotional learning needs.

Transition

As a school we recognise the importance of transition for our children and as a result, we will be arranging transition activities this year. From Monday 14th July, your child/ren will move into their

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new class with their new staff. Throughout the duration of the week they will engage in fun transition activities with their new teachers and begin to plan for the new academic year. Due to transition week and the way in which this will be enabled to take place, the children's last day with their current class teacher will be Friday 11th July.

Our current year 6 will be based in the school hall from Monday 14th July where they too will engage in a range of fun, end of primary school activities. Your child's chosen secondary school will make contact with you directly regarding their transition into High School.

School uniform

School uniform helps play a valuable role in contributing to the ethos of the school and sets the appropriate tone. If you require support in purchasing uniform, a copy of the uniform grant form is available on our school website. We also have our uniform swap shop where you can pass on old uniform in exchange for second hand uniform that is in a very good condition.
