Science & Technology:

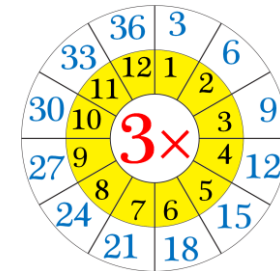
Choose a dinosaur and research the habitat it lived in. How was the dinosaur adapted to its environment. Draw and label the adaptations.
